

There are many rivers which flow across Sierra Leone—generally in a northeast to southwest direction into the Atlantic. The floodplains of these rivers provide fertile soil for farming. The climate is tropical, with high temperatures and humidity throughout the year.

Sierra Leone has four regions the Northern Province, Southern Province, the Eastern Province and the Western Area. The first three provinces are divided into 12 districts. The districts are further divided into 149 chiefdoms.
